

## REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING

AUGUST 18, 2009

Mayor Richard Rodriguez called the City of Elkhart council meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. in the council room.

Those present: John Meek, Tim Predmore, Tony Hoyt, Kelly Howe and Jeremy Lavielle.

Councilmember Mo Pando was absent.

Others attending: Tim Hardy, Matt Higgins, Justin Groth and William Graybill.

Prayer and Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag opened the meeting. Minutes for the August 4<sup>th</sup> council meeting were approved with motion from Councilmember Hoyt and second from Councilmember Howe. Motion passed.

A motion by Councilmember Predmore to approve the disbursements was seconded by Councilmember Meek. Motion passed.

Motion by Councilmember Howe for city to repair and replace 2 sections of curb and guttering from the alley on Sid Street to intersection of Colorado Street & Sid was seconded by Tony. Motion carried.

Water Superintendent Matt Higgins reported to council on concerns of the Ground Water Rule put into place by KDHE to achieve 4 log treatment of water. Matt is to get more information for council on the cost of project.

A motion to deny request for water meter outside the city limits for Brandon Lewis was made by Councilmember Lavielle and seconded by Councilmember Predmore. Motion passed.

Thermo imaging unit used to detect hot spots in fires was requested by the fire department.

A motion by Councilmember Meek to purchase the thermo imaging unit in the amount of \$4,950.00 for the fire department was seconded by Councilmember Howe. Motion carried.

Motion by Councilmember Predmore to approve the assessed bill for Jack Hayward property clean-up was seconded by Councilmember Meek. Motion passed.
